New London City Manager **Marty Berliner** addressed the club on June 30th. After a twenty-eight year career as City Manager in Mansfield, CT, Marty retired briefly in 2006 before being persuaded to come to New London for a temporary six-month assignment. That temporary assignment is now approaching four years. Born and raised in Hartford, Berliner was interested in New London and returning to an urban environment. Upon entering New London what jumped out initially was how decrepit and rundown the community was. Marty has made upgrading the city's infrastructure a main priority. During his tenure the city has invested in rebuilding the downtown Parade, the New London High School Sports Complex, five playscapes throughout the city along with an aggressive road-resurfacing program with new sidewalks and granite curbing. He strongly believes that by the city showing improvements that the citizenry will follow. An example is the citywide Clean Sweep program to address junk cars, blight and other housing and zoning issues. Folks for the most part are voluntarily taking steps to address the issues at hand. 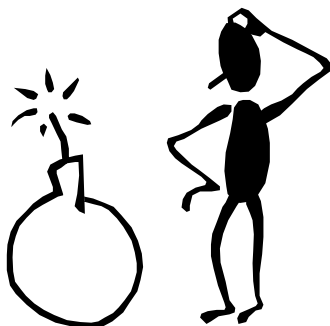
